Dear Resident:

The City of St. Paul will be holding a neighborhood meeting to discuss the proposed Jefferson Bikeway project. The date, time and location of the meeting are as follows.

The purpose of the meeting will be to provide a project update, the current project scope and the next steps in the process. As a reminder, and as shown in the figure on the reverse side, the project limits are Mississippi River Boulevard on the west end and Shepard Road & Cliff Avenue on the east end. The elements being considered for implementation on the various sections along Jefferson are stated below.

- Mississippi River Boulevard to Snelling
  - Installation destination/directional signs and route marker signs.
- Snelling to Lexington
  - Installation of "Sharrow" pavement markings and installation of destination/directional, route marker Dynamic Speed Display signs.
  - Test pedestrian/bicycle refuge/diverter at Cleveland Avenue.
- Lexington to West 7<sup>th</sup> Street
  - Restripe roadway to add bike lanes.
  - Construction of sidewalk on south side from Lexington to Victoria.
  - Construction of bump outs to improve pedestrian safety and calm traffic.
  - Reduce the speed limit between Victoria and Lexington from 40 mph to 30 mph.
  - Installation of lantern street lighting with 30% of the cost being assessed. The current rate is \$7.25 per assessable foot.
  - Installation of destination/directional signs.
  - Isolated locations of parking bans.
- East of West 7<sup>th</sup> Street:
  - Pavement markings and signs on: Jefferson: West 7<sup>th</sup> Street to Colborne Street; Duke Street: Jefferson Avenue to James Avenue; Colborne Street: Jefferson Avenue to Grace Street; Grace Street: Colborne Street to Western Avenue; Western Avenue: Grace Street to St. Clair Avenue.

It should be noted that, with the exception of the test refuge/diverter at Cleveland, the project scope for the section of Jefferson west of Lexington Parkway has changed such that only pavement markings and signs are being considered.
